






Ford Aerostar 1985-1991

- Remove (2) Phillips screws from the base of the dash trim bezel. (Figure A)
- Pry down on the (2) tabs located at the top of the dash trim bezel and remove the bezel.
- **3.** Remove (4) screws securing the factory radio, then unplug and remove the radio.
- **4.** Cut and remove all mounting tabs on radio housing #2 EXCEPT tabs "D" and "F". (Figure B)
- **5.** Locate *Spacer Set #1* (the spacers must be placed behind the mounting tabs during installation).





- **1.** Remove (2) screws from the top edge of the dash trim bezel. (Figure A)
- Pull out from the top of the bezel, unhook the base and remove the bezel. If a factory radio is NOT present, scribe the (4) mounting holes and radio opening onto the bezel.
- **3.** Drill the holes, cut the opening and place (4) U-clips over the mounting positions.
- **4.** Cut and remove all mounting tabs on radio housing #1 EXCEPT tab "B". (Figure B)





- Carefully pull and remove the dash trim bezel. (Figure A)
- Remove (4) screws securing the factory radio, then unplug and remove the radio.

- **4.** Locate *Spacer Set #1* (the spacers must be placed behind the mounting tabs during installation).

- **3.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly. (Figure A)


